

SPARKLING WINE

1. Casa Canevel Prosecco Extra Dry NV £8 / £35

Veneto, Italy

Supremely drinkable Prosecco: soft, aromatic, and fresh, balancing crisp apple and floral blossom notes carried by the gentle, seductive mousse.

CHAMPAGNE

125ml glass / 750ml bottle

2. Champagne Moutard Grand Cuvée NV £14 / £57

France

A bright Champagne with juicy black cherry and candied pink grapefruit. The Cuvée, a cornerstone of Moutard's production, has a refined, rich nose with notes of butter, almond, and brioche. Its palate is lively, elegant, and balanced with a good mouthfeel. Made from 80% Pinot Noir and 20% Chardonnay, sourced from 20-year-old vines.

3. Champagne Moutard Cuvaision Rosé NV £68

France

Ample nose with hints of red fruit and forest floor. Full-bodied palate with persistent, well-balanced spiced red berry flavours. Skin Contact method gives a soft pink colour. Aged 36 months on the lees in Moutard's chalk cellars.

4. Champagne Moutard Persin Blanc De Blancs NV £90

France

Fine mousse, delicate nose with floral and almond notes. In the mouth, it shows great persistence, a fresh finish, and a remarkable structure with lemon and grapefruit notes.

5. Champagne Moutard Cuvée Des 6 Cépages 2011 £195

France

The nose offers a festival of aromas: notes of iris, lime blossom, dried flowers, fresh almond, hazelnut, peach, pear and citrus fruits, combined with notes of vanilla and honey. The palate is in harmony with the nose. The fruity notes return with great persistence, long after the last sip.

PREMIUM SELECTION

6. Meursault, Henri de Villamont 2020 £145

France

A decadent Meursault with creamy-rich peach fruit, notes of grilled nuts, and a full-bodied palate, all balanced by a lovely streak of lemony acidity for focus and finesse.

7. Chassagne-Montrachet Blanc, Thomas Morey 2022 £155

Burgundy, France

Scintillating white Burgundy from this prestigious producer. The depth of fruit is expertly counterbalanced by fresh, racy accents – the finish is lingering and elegant.

8. Condrieu Les Mandouls, Ferraton 2022 £100

Rhône Valley, France

Distinctive Condrieu with ripe peach, apricot, and honeysuckle flavours. Well-balanced acidity and a silky palate typical of the appellation.

9. Ridge Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 £145

California, USA

From the renowned Ridge Vineyards, voted best fine winery in the Americas, comes this outstanding Cabernet with concentrated blackcurrant and blackberry flavours, supple tannins, and subtle oak.

10. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Omnia, R&M Saouma 2020 £175

Rhône, France

This robust, intense wine combines delicacy and power, boasting rich dark fruit flavours with notes of oak and spice, and a long, smooth, elegant finish.

11. Nuits-St-Georges Vieilles Vignes, Alain Michelot 2020 £115

Burgundy, France

Stunning Burgundy from a renowned winemaker, featuring classic Pinot Noir with juicy redcurrant flavours and subtle savoury notes on an opulent finish.

WHITE WINE

12. *Pasqua Colori Pinot Grigio 2023* £8 / £29

Italy

A fragrant, fruity and structured wine with floral acacia blossom notes and pear like hints on the nose. It's easy-drinking, fresh, intense, and excellently well-balanced.

13. *Foxwood Dawn Picked Viognier 2023* £34

Languedoc-Roussillon, France

This wine has classic Viognier characters of ripe apricot and summer flowers. Medium-full in body, with a soft texture and a refreshing streak of citrus.

14. *Morandé Gewurztraminer Gran Reserva 2023* £10 / £37

Aconcagua, Chile

The ideal white wine for spicier dishes, featuring aromas of rose and orange blossom and flavours of lychee, mandarin, and gingery spice, all harmoniously integrated on the palate.

15. *Albariño Sobre Lías, Casal Caeiro 2022* £13 / £45

Galicia, Spain

From Rías Baixas' coolest area, this Albariño bursts with pear, citrus, musky perfume, and hints of mineral and spice. Clean, intense, and very long on the palate.

16. *Pulenta Estate VIII Chardonnay 2022* £40

Mendoza, Argentina

Ripe tropical fruit flavours are complemented by fresh citrus notes and oak-driven toasted almond and coconut. The result is a perfect blend of elegance and richness.

17. *Babich Family Reserve Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2023* £12 / £42

Marlborough, New Zealand

Zesty aromas of grapefruit and lemon are followed by gooseberry, blackcurrant leaf and mineral notes, with a seam of crisp acidity on the lingering finish.

18. *Corralillo Riesling, Matetic (Organic) 2023* £11 / £40

Aconcagua, Chile

A dry, zesty Riesling with both tropical and mineral expressions. Classic hints of flint on the nose, bright acidity, and a firm citrus-driven finish.

19. *Lievlander Chenin Blanc 2023* £9 / £34

Coastal Region, South Africa

Vibrant quince, pear, and pineapple aromas lead to stone fruit and apple flavours with a distinct mineral note. The medium-weight palate is nicely textured, with a fine streak of acidity on the finish.

20. *Pinot Gris Pierres Sèches, Muré (Organic) 2022* £48

Alsace, France

Richly dry with spiced pear flavours, clean citrus balance, and a positive finish. An outstanding wine from this renowned twelfth-generation family.

21. *Pouilly-Fumé Les Chailloux Silex, Chatelain 2022* £50

Loire Valley, France

A lively, intense nose of crisp green fruit, with focused mineral notes on the palate backed up by citrus and subtle spice and mint flavours.

22. *Chablis 1er Cru Vau Ligneau, Hamelin 2022* £65

Burgundy, France

The Hamelin family's flagship Chablis, from six generations of grape growing, features rich citrus flavours, crisp minerality, and a long, elegant finish.

23. *Carneros Chardonnay, Buena Vista 2022* £70

California, USA

Ripe tropical and citrus flavours harmonise with subtle oak and vanilla notes on a round, satisfying finish.

Where a particular vintage is not available, we shall offer a suitable alternative.

ROSÉ WINE

24. *Les Cerisiers Côtes du Rhône Rosé 2023* £9 / £32
France

An elegant, gastronomic Rhône rosé in classic salmon pink. It has delicate rosehip syrup, wild berry blossoms, and cherry aromas. Full-flavoured, ripe, and balanced with textured berry fruit and a refreshing raspberry twist on the finish. Deliciously balanced and moreish.

25. *Terre del Noce Pinot Grigio Rosé 2023* £34
Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy

From northeast Italy, this cool-climate rosé features aromas and flavours of fresh summer berries with a crisp, dry, and fresh finish.

RED WINE

26. *Pasqua Colori Merlot 2022* £8 / £29
Italy

Scents of blackcurrants and herbaceous hints. The palate features rounded fruit, velvety tannins, and great length and persistence.

27. *Pinot Noir Pays d'Oc, Badet Clément 2022* £11 / £40
Languedoc-Roussillon, France

An elegant Pinot Noir with bright cherry and berry fruit, supple tannins, and a medium body. Gentle spice notes and balanced acidity enhance the classy finish.

28. *Codici Masserie Primitivo 2022* £34
Puglia, Italy

This full-bodied Primitivo offers abundant red berry alongside notes of dark fruit jam. The palate is soft and well-rounded, with a hint of spice on the finish.

29. *Chianti Superiore, Santa Cristina 2021* £47
Tuscany, Italy

A classic Chianti from the Antinori family with red berry, vanilla, and floral aromas. The medium-bodied palate is fresh, flavorful, and balanced with fruit and savoury notes.

30. *Mathilda Shiraz, Tournon 2020* £12 / £42
Victoria, Australia

Deep black fruit aromas lead to a palate with elegant, silky tannins. The finish is spicy, savoury, long, and smooth.

31. *Norton Winemakers Reserve Malbec 2022* £45
Mendoza, Argentina

From mature vines grown at high altitude in the foothills of the Andes, this sumptuous Malbec is round and velvety, with flavours of ripe black fruit, violets, spices and tobacco.

32. *Cantos de Valpiedra, Rioja 2019* £14 / £50
Rioja, Spain

From "The Valley of the Stones," a superb single-vineyard Rioja with velvety ripe strawberry flavours, toasty oak, and creamy vanilla notes.

33. *Château Lalande de Gravet, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru 2018* £65
Bordeaux, France

Superb right-bank Bordeaux, Merlot-led, with delicious dark stone fruit flavours and subtle tobacco and spice accents.

34. *Costasera Amarone Classico, Masi 2018* £105
Italy

Bright and intense with preserved cherries, dried plums, forest fruits, and cinnamon. The palate is smooth and sumptuous, with a luxurious, seemingly endless finish.
